HEALTH AND SAFETY

Orosur's overreaching objective with respect to its staff and local peoples is that of zero harm.

As an exploration company operating across remote regions, in difficult and rugged terrain in three countries, our staff are naturally exposed to a range of unusual risks and hazards. Each operation and activity will require its own specific operating protocols.

In all instances, our operations are planned in such a way as to ensure a safe working environment for our staff and those involved in and impacted by our activities.



COMMUNITY

Orosur's exploration activities across South America, will by definition, interact with local communities to widely varying degrees.

In all instances, we work on the fundamental basis of a "licence to operate" in the sense that not only do we adhere to all local laws and regulations, but we require the consent of local communities and land owners for all activities that we undertake.

This requires extensive community consultation and planning of activities so that the impact on local communities are minimised and that potentially positive impacts, such as employment and economic benefits, are maximised.



ENVIRONMENT

Exploration and Mining by definition, will impact upon local environments, to greater or lesser degrees.

As a minimum, Orosur will always adhere strictly to local environmental laws and regulations, but as a general rule, we would operate to the higher international standards if that is appropriate.

We operate across diverse terrains, from deserts, to forests to farming areas, and as each environment requires dedicated operating standards and protocols.
